

## LAPIS GLOBAL TOP 25 CRYPTO ASSET LIST Q4-2023

The **Lapis Global Top 25 Crypto Asset Index** is composed of the worldwide largest 25 crypto assets, also known as cryptocurrencies. Only crypto assets that are easily tradable and meet the high security standards of our custodian are considered. Moreover, all stablecoins, privacy coins and fun tokens are excluded. In addition, we use a three-stage equal weighting model in our index calculation. The largest three crypto assets are weighted with 15% each, the crypto assets ranked as 4th and 5th are weighted with 7.5% each, and the last 20 crypto assets are weighted with 2% each. The rule-based index is rebalanced on a quarterly basis (end of January, April, July, and October).

LINK	<b>Chainlink</b> 	Decentralized Ecosystems	<b>6'472'827'537</b>	11.61	73.82	-71.57	108.35	ERC20 token for the decentralized Oracle network Chainlink. Allows Smart Contracts on ETH to securely connect to external data sources, APIs and payment systems.

BCH	<b>Bitcoin Cash</b> 	Payment Tokens	<b>4'790'551'559</b>	246.64	25.53	-77.46	154.08	Hard fork of Bitcoin that was created in August 2017. Created to address the Bitcoin scalability problem by increasing the block size.
XLM	<b>Stellar</b> 	Payment Tokens	<b>3'415'659'375</b>	0.1226	108.26	-73.39	72.31	Stellar is a cross border payment network. The native token, lumens, allows for cheap and fast interbank transactions. It is a hard fork of the Ripple blockchain.
UNI	<b>Uniswap</b> 	Decentralized Exchanges	<b>2'806'002'608</b>	4.76	230.17	-69.77	-7.77	An ERC20 token that powers Uniswap. Decentralized Exchange for the trading of ERC20 Tokens based on liquidity pools that are defined by smart contracts.
OKB	<b>OKB</b> 	Exchange-based Tokens	<b>2'763'585'584</b>	46.06	270.44	-9.78	77.15	A global utility token issued by the OK Blockchain Foundation. OKB is used to pay transaction fees on the OKEx Exchange and is also used in the decentralized apps (DApps) developed on OKChain.
